




ALTERNATIVE LAYOUT 2 - Markets / Food events




ALTERNATIVE LAYOUT 3 - Exhibition Space


OPTION 4 - VISUAL 1 Exterior visualisation of front of Church, illustrating the new extension being in-keeping with the existing building fabric.




OPTION 4 - VISUAL 2 Interior of Church with new internal door, leading to accessible WC.

OPTION 4

- * Introduction of new Tea Kitchen to the interior of the Church.
- * Font relocated to the front of the Church.
- * A small extension is created to
- provide an accessible WC, which can be accessed directly from the Church.
- * Room for storage at the back of the Church, which would not cause much obstruction to activities.
- * Impact to heritage asset of extension minimised by keeping extension to minimum area and detailing it to match the existing Church.

Things to consider...

- + More space within the Church is created by the WC being provided within an extension.
- + Kitchen and WC accessible from inside the Church.
- + New elements to the Church
 such as the Kitchen and new
 interior door leading to WC to
 be in keeping with existing
 Church features.
- WC extension is potentially more expensive than locating within the existing building.
